An Update from the Board



The Board continues to work with the Village of Hartland on "unfinished business" of the Developer. On January 26th, 2007 we were copied on a comprehensive punch list complete with photographs and markings on the original landscape plan approved by the village. There are a number of items relating to drainage, and plantings that require viewing during the spring growing season. The Board has also had a few conversations with the Developer and hopes to coordinate some of the punch list items with our planned landscaping work in the spring.

The Board has also spoke to the Village about the topsoil stock pile on the east side of the development. The Village is now asking for a time table from the Developer of when the stock pile and machinery will be completely removed. These and other important topics with be discussed at the February 13th Board Meeting.

The collection of 2007 Association Dues is almost complete. Thanks to all who have submitted their payments on a timely basis. For those members who remain unpaid, please be reminded that delinquent accounts will be posted to the Members Only section of the Website beginning next week in addition to the penalties imposed in the Association Bylaws.

Landscaping Update

Now that we have snow it's great to see the sledding hill get plenty of use. As always, a reminder that if anyone witnesses abuse of our property, trees, turf, fixtures, signs, etc. also please report that information to Terry. This includes un-authorized use of snowmobiles, ice-fishing, or skating on our private property.

In the recent budget meetings for 2007, it was decided to reduce the so-called "tractor mows" in certain areas of the development which will result in more of a prairie grass look throughout the summer. This will also eliminate the un-sightly "chopped up" appearance that occurred in mid-summer after tractor-mowing. We will continue to apply weed control to these areas.

Of a more general nature, there have been several instances reported where motorists have been using Greystone Blvd as a two way street. The HOB advises all homeowners to be alert to the possibility that a vehicle could come at you head on when traveling on Greystone. The HOB is considering the need for one-way signs for that street. Stay tuned for more landscape news as Spring draws closer.
