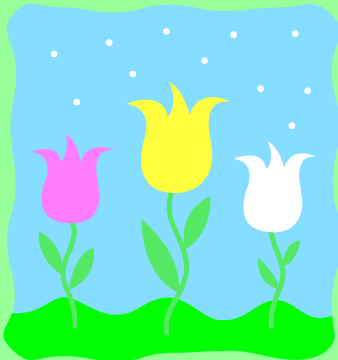

- 2/3c. corn starch
- 1c. flour

##### Directions:

Mix together corn starch, flour, & powdered sugar. Add butter. Mix well. Form into balls. Bake @ 325 degrees 15-20 min.. cool & frost.

##### Frosting:

- 4T. butter
- 2c. powdered sugar
- 2T lemon juice
- Rind of 1 lemon
