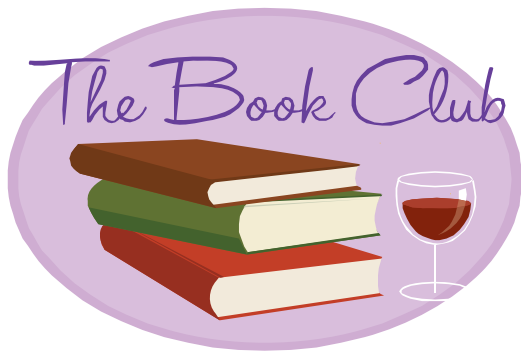




Book Club News
