Brownie Trifle Recipe

Ingredients

- 2 (21oz) pkgs chewy fudge brownie mix
- 1 (8oz) pkg cream cheese, softenend
- 1 (7oz) jar marshmallow cream
- 2 (8oz) containers of cool whip
- 3 cups skim milk
- 2 (3.3oz) pkgs instant white chocolate pudding mix
- 1 jar caramel topping

Directions

Prepare brownies. Cool. Break into chunks. beat cream cheese until cream. Beat in marshmallow cream. Sitr in 1 container of cool whip. Stir together mil & white chocolate pudding mix until thickened. Stir in remaining container of cool whip. Crumble half of brownie pieces in an even layer in bottom of a trifle bowl or 9 x 13 pan. Pour cream cheese mixture evenly over brownies; drizzle evenly with caramel topping. Pour pudding evenly over caramel topping. Crumble remaining brownie pieces over top. cover and chill 2 hrs. (can arrange in trifle bowl as well).
